- 4. The Second Meeting of Creditors will be convened to consider three resolutions concerning:
  - a. remuneration of the Proposal Trustee;
  - b. remuneration of the Bankruptcy Trustee; and
  - c. transferring the power to determine and approve remuneration of the trustee from the creditors of the estate to the inspectors of the estate.

To be entitled to vote at the meeting, a creditor must file with the trustee, before the meeting, a proof of claim (if a proof has already been submitted there is no requirement to resubmit a new proof of claim); and either

- a. submit a voting letter prior to the meeting by email or by post; or
- b. submit a proxy form prior to the meeting for someone to vote on their behalf who should then attend the meeting; or
- c. attend the meeting in person and complete a voting card.
