# **Australia**

#### Australia: NSW Government's Jobs Action Plan extended

The NSW government has recently passed legislation that extends the application of its Jobs Action Plan (the Plan) for a further 4 years until 30 June 2019.

To be eligible for the Plan the business must be registered as an employer and paying payroll tax in NSW.

#### Australia: SA moves to abolish stamp duty for business

The South Australian Treasurer has handed down the South Australian State Budget 2015-16, which includes a number of significant taxation measures.

These tax changes are expected to deliver almost \$670 million in tax reductions over the next 4 years and reductions of more than \$268 million each year from 2018–19.

#### Australia: The China-Australia Free Trade Agreement

The China-Australia Free Trade Agreement was signed on 17 June 2015 – an historic next step in Australia and China's relationship. However, full implementation is not expected until later this year. This interim period provides the opportunity for importers and exporters to complete internal and documentary processes to maximise the benefits of the Agreement.

# Cambodia: Notification calling for enterprises with tax debts to

The General Department of Taxation (GDT) issued a notification calling for all enterprises having outstanding tax debts with the GDT to settle them prior to the end of June 2015.

If enterprises fail to comply with the mentioned deadline, recovery measures in accordance with the Law on Taxation would be taken by the GDT including stopping of export-import operations, freezing of bank accounts, and nullifying of commercial permits and license etc.

### India

India: Long-term capital loss on sale of shares/units liable to securities transaction tax is allowed to be set-off against long-term capital gain on sale of land

The Mumbai Bench of the Income-tax Appellate Tribunal has held that long-term capital losses on the sale of shares/units of a mutual fund which are liable to Securities Transaction Tax (STT) can be set-off against long-term capital gains arising on sale of land.

The newly issued Circular has provided certain details/processes for regulations on share based employee benefits, which were issued by the Securities Exchange Board of India on 28 October 2014.

#### Vietnam: FATCA guidance, extended reporting deadline

The State Bank of Vietnam has issued an Official Letter providing further guidance to financial institutions and branches of foreign banks for implementation of Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act ('FATCA'). The main guidance includes:

- The FATCA reporting deadline (requests for an automatic 90-day extension to be filed by 29 June 2015)
- A waiver for filing Form 8966 electronically, in hardship cases, if requested by 13 August 2015
