Cabinet Approves Draft Law on Electronic Invoicing

We are sending this email to inform you about the recent development in Qatar's tax and digital landscape. The Cabinet, at its weekly meeting held on 6 May 2026 at the Amiri Diwan, approved a draft law on electronic invoicing and its implementing regulations. The draft law, prepared by the Ministry of Finance in coordination with the General Tax Authority, is intended to establish a comprehensive legal framework for the issuance of electronic invoices and related notifications. It aims to enhance transparency, support the country's digital transformation agenda in the tax and financial sectors, and provide reliable databases for regulatory and oversight purposes.

What does this mean for your businesses?

The implementation of electronic invoicing will require businesses to assess readiness across invoicing and ERP systems and processes ensuring compliance with forthcoming technical specifications, and coordinating closely with IT and Finance teams and consultants to support a successful implementation. At the same time, the new framework will provide an opportunity for businesses to enhance efficiency, improve data accuracy, and strengthen control and governance over their invoicing and reporting processes.
