


# Consumer & Retail (C&R)—American Worker Survey

Job satisfaction and attitudes on automation and 4-day work weeks




42% of C&R workers have considered leaving their company in the last year

## Work-life balance is a top priority for C&R workers

46% say automation has **improved** their professional abilities


