## South Korea: Issued Revised CRS Regulations

On 31 December 2024, South Korea issued a revised version of its CRS Regulations, which includes the following updates:

- Updated the list of Participating Jurisdiction (Appendix 3). Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine were added to the list.
- Updated the list of Reportable Jurisdiction (Appendix 4). Belize, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine were added to the list.
