IRS correction: Extended filing deadline for Forms 1042-S is April 16, 2025

The IRS today issued a reminder regarding the extended the deadline for filing Forms 1042-S for the tax year 2024.

According to the [IRS transmittal message](#) (April 9, 2025), the deadline to file Forms 1042-S is April 16, 2025,* if an automatic 30-day extension was requested in a timely manner. An additional 30-day extension is not automatic and requires submission of [Form 8809, Application for Extension of Time to File Information Returns](#), before the initial extension expires. The automatic extension does not apply to providing Forms 1042-S to recipients.

*A prior [IRS transmittal message](#) (April 8, 2025) stated that the deadline was April 14, 2025. The IRS today issued a correction noting that the deadline is actually April 16, 2025.
