Switzerland: Protocol Signed with EU Amending the AEOI Agreement

On 20 October 2025, Switzerland signed a protocol amending its agreement with the European Union (EU) on the automatic exchange of financial account information (AEOI), in alignment with the OECD's revised Common Reporting Standard (CRS 2.0).

The amending protocol introduces an exemption for Swiss-based Qualified Non-Profit Entities from financial account reporting requirements. All other provisions of the current AEOI agreement remain unchanged and will continue to apply under the existing framework.

The protocol will undergo a public consultation before being presented to the Swiss Parliament for approval.
