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Legislative update: President Trump signs into law Disaster Related Extension of Deadlines Act

President Trump has signed into law [H.R. 1491](#), the “Disaster Related Extension of Deadlines Act,” which grants taxpayers afforded extended deadlines due to a disaster additional time to claim tax refunds or credits.

The bill was passed by the House of Representatives on April 1, 2025, and passed by the Senate on December 11, 2025.

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) disaster declarations allow certain employer-sponsored charities—including private foundations and donor-advised funds—to provide direct assistance to employees and their families impacted by qualifying disasters.
