Bahamas: Advisory Issued on FATCA/CRS Reporting Deadline and CRS Bulk Registration Facility

On 27 May 2026, the Bahamas Competent Authority issued an advisory notice to Reporting Financial Institutions (RFIs), confirming that the statutory FATCA and CRS reporting deadline for the 2025 reporting period remains 30 June 2026.

However, RFIs have been granted administrative relief for this reporting period, under which no penalties will be imposed for submissions made on or before 31 July 2026.

Notably, this administrative relief does not apply to subsequent years. Accordingly, the standard reporting deadline of 30 June will apply, and late submissions may be subject to applicable penalties.

CRS Bulk Registration Facility:

Additionally, the Competent Authority reminds RFIs, including those with no reportable accounts, and Non-Reporting Financial Institutions (NRFIs), of the mandatory registration deadline of 15 June 2026.

To support compliance for RFIs or service providers with 200 or more entities to register, the Competent Authority has introduced a bulk registration facility:

- Entities intending to use the bulk registration facility must first notify the regulator at helpdesk@taxreporting.finance.gov.bs, through their usual contact person, confirming their intention to use the facility.
- Upon receiving confirmation, requests for bulk registration access should be submitted to the same email address, with

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a copy to the CRS Coordinator at sanrafoster@bahamas.gov.bs.

The bulk registration facility does not extend or modify the mandatory registration deadline of 15 June 2026.
