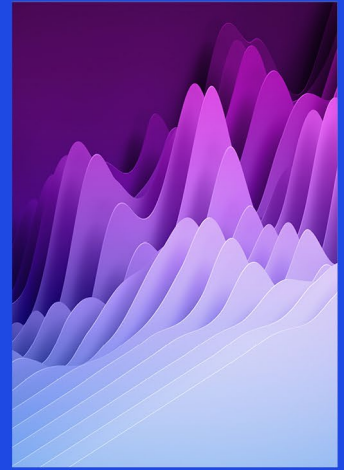

Barbados: Extends FATCA and CRS Reporting Deadline

On 14 August 2026, the Barbados Revenue Authority (BRA) issued Guidance Note OGC No. 16/2026 through an email circular announcing an extension of the FATCA and CRS reporting deadline for the 2025 reporting period to 11 September 2026.

The BRA advised that recent updates to the AEOI portal have been completed. As a result, all Reporting Barbados Financial Institutions (RBFIs) that submitted FATCA or CRS reports between 23 July 2026 and 6 August 2026 are required to resubmit their reports.

The BRA further reminded RBFIs that failure to submit the required reports may result in penalties of \$50,000, imprisonment for a term of up to 10 years, or both, under Regulation 20 of the Income Tax (Automatic Exchange of Information) Regulations, 2017 (AEOI Regulations) (found [here](#)). In addition, the Revenue Commissioner may impose a further pecuniary penalty of \$10,000 under Regulation 21(1)(a) of the AEOI Regulations for non-compliance with the reporting requirements.
